



Prepare work area

Large fully planted Islandscapes can be difficult to move on dry land. For large Islandscapes (IP300 & IP400), place a tarp at the shoreline or pond edge. Use the tarp as a work area, then when you are ready to launch the slippery surface makes it easy to slide the Islandscape into the water.

Two Methods for Tethering

a) Islandscapes can be tied to the shoreline for easy maintenance; some people do this the first few weeks while their island is establishing itself.

ANCHOR

) Alternately you can ties Islandscapes to a heavy submerged object. For ponds with EPDM liners, use Freedom's SafeAnchor,TM a soft anchoring system that contours to the bottom of your pond. (sold separately)









FLEXI-MIX

a) Turn the Islandscape right side up. Remove as many (or as few) of the 3" pocket plugs as your planting design requires. (You can utilize 1" wicking channels for smaller plants.)




b) Fill the planting pockets generously with Islandscapes Flexi-Mix.

c) Press Flexi-Mix into each of the 1" wicking channels. Use firm pressure to eliminate air. Cover island completely with remaining Flexi-Mix.

IMPORTANT

Use of garden variety soil mix will void your warranty & inhibit plant growth. Islandscapes Flexi-Mix offers superior wicking properties (raising water to a height of 7 inches) and its light weight minimizes negative buoyancy allowing for more densely planted Islands.



Traditional turf is laden with soil and too heavy for most islands to support. Freedom recommends that you wash roots to remove soil or purchase soil-less turf from a

a) Simply roll turf onto your Islandscape so that its surface is completely covered.

Use landscape flags to keep track of underlying planting pockets while you are fitting the turf into position.

- b) Trim turf with a serrated knife so that there is a roughly 3 inch overlap; the turf should be flush with the water line when launched.
- c) Use metal landscape pins to secure Islandscape - place pins at one foot the outside edge of the Islandscape (see illustration below)

PLANT

- a) Rinse the soil off terrestrial plants to expose
-) Place plants into the Islandscape Flexi-Mix as you would any planting bed. If using seeds, simply press the seeds into the Flexi-Mix.







- e) Pat down the Growing Media firmly.
- 1) The rest of the island should be seeded with wildflowers or covered with grass for a natural appearance. This will also protect the bio-matrix from the sun's UV rays. (Like most fibers the biomatrix will eventually break down if left unprotected in full sun exposure.)



e) If planting into a turf covered Islandscape, cut around each flag to expose the planting pockets beneath.

Use a durable serrated knife to cut through turf roots and reach the planting pockets.




LAUNCH

- a) Pick up the anchor, or place it on top of the Islandscape. Slide or lift your Islandscape into the water.
-) Lower the anchor when the Islandscape reaches the desired location in your pond.
- c) The top edge of the Islandscape should sit 3 to 5 inches above the water. As a rule of thumb, if half the thickness of the island is showing above water, your Islandscape is floating optimally. If the island floats unevenly or rides too high, you can add evenly spaced landscape rocks to the top of the island. Often these can be removed in a week or so, after the plant roots have grown through the media to the water below.



The bottom of the wicking channels must be in contact with the water so that wicking action can occur. Confirm that the Growing Media is appropriately moist after launch. You can adjust buoyancy by adding or subtracting rocks to the top of the





• Check the Islandscape a few days after launch to ensure that water is reaching plant roots.

Alternately, if the Islandscape is sitting too low it may appear waterlogged. In either case, you
